

Descaling Dishwashing Machines

Before you start

- ✓ Read label directions and Safety Data Sheets (SDS) of chemicals prior to use.
- √ Wear Personal Protective Equipment as per the SDS such as safety glasses and suitable gloves when handling chemicals.
- ✓ NEVER MIX CHEMICALS.
- ✓ Turn OFF chemical dispenser.
- ✓ Empty the dishwashing machine.
- √ Follow all dishwashing machine manufacturer instructions.

Pre-rinsing the machine

- 1. Fill the dishwashing machine with clean water.
- 2. Run one full wash cycle.

Descaling the machine

- 1. Add 250ml of DESCALE to dishwasher or washing machine.
- 2. Run through cycle for a minimum of 10 minutes.
- 3. Ensure no other chemicals are used and that chemical feed pumps are turned off or disabled during use.
- 3. Rinse with water.
- 4. Repeat if necessary until you are happy with the appearance of the machine.
- 6. Empty the dishwashing machine.

Setting up the machine for use

- 1. Fill the dishwashing machine with clean water.
- 2. Run one full wash cycle.
- 3. Empty the dishwashing machine.
- 4. Ensure that no DESCALE is left in the dishwasher before the chemical dispenser is turned on.
- 5. Turn ON the chemical dispenser.
- 6. Refill the dishwashing machine and titrate the wash water to ensure correct dispenser set up.
